**\*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\* AAC ID CARDS**

If your dog does not have an AAC ID CARD, please order it yourself before the trial. All dogs must have an ID Card to compete in AAC events. These Cards are used to record the dog's height and eliminate the need for measuring when they have been signed by the required number of judges.

***If your dog does not have a completed AAC Measurement card – you must have your dog measured before you attempt to check-in.***

## Equipment Familiarization:

Equipment familiarization will be from **8:00 – 8:15 AM** on Sunday for Starters dogs only.

All obstacles conform to AAC specifications.

- Self-healing tire
- Loud horn may be used for some gambler runs
- Manual timing
- Vinyl wing and wingless
- Vinyl Double and Spread
- Rubberized contacts

**Move-ups:** Same day move-ups will be available.

Move ups will be allowed during the trial. Please make sure to let the trial secretary know before the end of Saturday for Sunday Move ups.



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**Crating and Set-Up:** There is space for crating inside our crating barn and in the indoor ring. Please do not block scoreboards, doorways, walkways, etc. Leaving valuables onsite is at the risk of the owner.

**Veterinarian on Call:** to be announced

**Prizes and Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place and rosettes/ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs.

## Trial Site

Trial will be held **OUTDOORS** on SPORTMIX.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There is a gun range near the property. Most dogs don't react, but if this is a concern, please contact us.

Maps will be e-mailed out 2 hours before the trial start time each day. Maps will also be posted on site.

**Food:** There is no onsite eatery - please bring your own Lunch. We will have some Snacks, Coffee and Tea available on site by donation with **all proceeds going to UNHCR Ukraine**. If anyone would like to bring treats, they will be very much appreciated by everyone! Microwave and Fridge also on site.

**Clean up:** Please everyone, pick up after your dog (Off leash as well as on leash)

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## Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of the AAC, including but not limited to the following:

This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, pure breed or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Under the AAC pilot project, bitches in season (BIS) may participate but we must be notified ahead of time. Handlers must limit movement of the BIS and only use the designated relief area. A BIS must wear panties at all times on the property, except while running or in the designated relief area. The BIS will run at the end of each class and the handler must provide a mat for the start line. Competitors who chose not to compete because there is a BIS will be offered a credit for the next trial.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specification.

No leads, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No choke, pinch or electronic collars allowed on site at any time. Close fitting collars with no attachments may be worn on course. Competitors may place the dog's leash in their pockets when running the course. The leash must be small enough to fit completely inside the pocket. Note: if the dog grabs the leash while running or jumps at the handler's pocket to attempt to interact with the leash, this will be scored as an "E" (toy in the ring). If the leash falls out of the pocket during the run and the dog does not interact with it, there will be no fault.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and / or children. Any competitor whose dogs and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.

All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.

Competitors MUST keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Anyone who does not clean up after themselves or their dogs may be required to leave the show grounds and no refund will be given.

There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for injured dogs and move ups. There will be a \$20 administration fee applied for all withdrawals after closing.

Visit protocols will be in place, as effective on the date of the trial.



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
